**IMPORTANT RECEIVER NOTICE REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF PROVIDER CLAIMS**

You are receiving this notice because our records indicate that you were a provider of health care services (“Provider”) to members, enrollees, or policyholders (collectively, “Members”) of Nevada Health CO-OP (“NHC”). NHC was placed into court-ordered receivership on October 1, 2015. The Commissioner of the Nevada Division of Insurance, Barbara D. Richardson, is the Receiver for NHC, and CANTILO & BENNETT, L.L.P. is the appointed Special Deputy Receiver (“SDR”). The Receiver has focused on resolving claims and collecting NHC’s assets so that payments may be made to Providers from NHC’s available funds. **This notice is to inform you of the status of payments for Provider services.**

NHC expects to continue to receive and process Provider claims data throughout this year. The SDR will soon request that the Eighth Judicial District Court of Clark County, Nevada establish a filing deadline for the submission of Provider and other claims. Receivership updates and further information about this deadline will be available on NHC’s web site ([www.nevadahealthcoop.org](http://www.nevadahealthcoop.org)), and may also be provided separately. **IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT PROVIDERS AND PARTIES INTERESTED IN THE NHC RECEIVERSHIP REVIEW THE WEB SITE REGULARLY TO REMAIN ABREAST OF CURRENT DEVELOPMENTS.**

The financial difficulties faced by NHC are severe, and funds currently available are insufficient for the payment of amounts owed to Providers. The Receiver and SDR are working hard to collect as much additional money for NHC as possible so that amounts owed to Providers and other creditors can be paid, at least in part. However, many of the amounts the SDR is attempting to collect are the subject of vigorous disputes and other impediments. It is difficult at this time to project a timeframe for asset collections and provider payments.

**Please remember that Providers are permanently restrained by NHC’s Receivership Order (previously provided and found on our web site) from seeking payment from any Member for amounts owed the Provider by NHC. Failure to abide by the terms of the NHC Receivership Order and existing agreements with NHC may result in waiver of the right to collect future payments from NHC, and may also result in legal enforcement action.**

We are very much aware of the tremendous hardships caused by NHC’s financial difficulties and will continue to pursue efforts designed to facilitate the payment of amounts owed by NHC.
